All publications can be downloaded, or viewed online with the Bepress Viewer, from either the main SWODA website (<u>https://swoda.uwindsor.ca/swoda-publications</u>) or from Scholarship@UWindsor (<u>https://scholar.uwindor.ca/swoda</u>).

All publications can also be viewed online or downloaded from the Internet Archive (<u>https://archive.org</u>). With the potential demise of Scholarship@UWindsor and the underlying BePress software, we are bringing together individual records in the Internet Archive and forming collections, where possible. Internet Archive collections must have at least 50 items. To-date, we have 3 Internet Archive collections: Le Rempart (Windsor, Ontario), The Lance: University of Windsor Student Newspaper, and Windsor (Ontario) City Directories.

The original .tiff and pdf files are stored on the SWODA s: drive, on a server in Information Technology Services. They are also mirrored on the Ontario Library Research Cloud. Finally, there is a backup on the SWODA external hard drives.

Statistical Overview

Because of the difficulties in obtaining annual statistics from the Internet Archive, the usage statistics presented are cumulative (to June 30th, 2024) for both platforms.

All 21 collections saw moderate increases in usage during 2023-2024. The Essex County (Ontario) High School Yearbooks, the City of Windsor Directories, the Windsor and Region Publications, the University of Windsor Calendars and the Lance collections were particularly well used.

New Collections

5 new collections were added to SWODA Publications in 2023-2024:

Alumni Times (Assumption University/University of Windsor)

The Alumni Times was a quarterly (later 3x/year) newsletter published by the Alumni Association of Assumption University, later the University of Windsor. It continued the Assumption College Alumni Chatter and appeared for over 20 years, from April 1956 until Winter 1977? There are 21 volumes in this collection. This collection was digitized in support of the Alumni Association and its work to celebrate the University's 60th anniversary celebrations.

Assumption College Alumni Chatter

The Alumni Chatter was a monthly newsletter published by the Alumni Association of Assumption College. It appeared for over 15 years, from November 1940 until December 1955. There are 16 volumes in this collection. This collection was digitized in support of the Alumni Association and its work to celebrate the University's 60th anniversary celebrations.

Le Rempart (Windsor, Ontario)

Le Rempart is an important French language newspaper of Windsor and the surrounding region. For the French-speaking minority, it acts as a showcase for the community and demonstrates its ongoing vitality. The newspaper was founded in 1966 by the Saint-Jean-Baptiste Society of Western Ontario and is currently published by Denis Poirier and Altomédia. This collection will cover the newspaper archive from 1966 to the early 2000s, when completed. To-date, the collection comprises 408 records. We are currently working in the early 1990s. This title is being digitized at the request of the owner, as well as several faculty members and outside researchers.

The Essex Scottish Regiment War Diaries

The War Diaries document the actions and experiences of the Essex Scottish Regiment (Windsor) during World War II. There are 6 volumes in the collection. The war diaries were digitized primarily because of the poor, and deteriorating, condition of the volumes.

Windsor Teachers College Yearbook

The Windsor Teachers' College was founded in 1962 and located in South Windsor. With the publication and governmental acceptance of the MacLeod Report, teacher education was moved to the universities. The Windsor Teachers' College became the Faculty of Education, University of Windsor, on July 1, 1970. A yearbook was published every year from 1963-1970. It was called the Magister. There are 8 volumes in the collection.

They include the undergraduate calendars: 1986 onwards, the graduate calendars: 1959 onwards, the general calendars: 1956-1986, and other calendars (1959-1977) put out by individual faculties and the Division of Extension (Continuing Education). We worked with the Registrar's Office, the Senate, and IT Services to convert the born digital volumes from Lotus Notes to pdf format. As a result, 107 new volumes were uploaded in 2023-2024.

As of June 30th, 2024, the database contains 3,589 historical photographs, postcards, and ephemera of southwestern Ontario – primarily of Windsor and Essex County. For a variety of technical reasons, there are no reliable usage statistics for SWODA Images this year. However, the cumulative number of page views since July 1st, 2011 is well over 2 million.

During Summer 2023, Twitter was rebranded as X, and Tweetdeck ceased to exist, making it difficult to schedule regular tweets. As a result, there are now only occasional postings to the account: SWODA@SWODAUWindsor.

The original .tiff and jpg files are stored on the SWODA s: drive, on a server in IT Services. They are also mirrored on the Ontario Library Research Cloud. Finally, there is a backup on the SWODA external hard drives. The SWODA Images records (images connected with relevant metadata) were permafrosted during the Summer of 2019. Only a few hundred new images have been added since then. During 2023-2024, the database and web pages were moved to a secure server (SSL certification) in IT Services. Because of the uncertainty surrounding the Drupal platform, we have begun to copy SWODA Images over to the Internet Archive. Up to now, about a third of the postcards have been copied. They are part of the University of Windsor collection and can be identified by the Topic: Southwestern Ontario Digital Archive Postcards

SWODA Annual Report 2023-2024 Additional Activities and Notes

We are continuing to work on the French-language newspaper, Le Rempart. We have already completed the years 1966-1992. We will digitize the volumes up to about 2003. There are also some earlier bulletins of the same name that we intend to include in the collection. We should likely be finished by the end of October.

We are also working on the LaSalle News, a local newspaper that was published from 1947-1963. Only scattered issues remain and they are in very poor condition. The newspaper is currently on loan to our Archives and Special Collections.

During 2023-2024, a number of articles about SWODA collections have appeared in both the Leddy Library blog and the University of Windsor Daily News. For example: <u>Historic</u> <u>francophone newspaper to be archived and digitized at Leddy Library</u>

I am also still working on expanding and updating "A brief history of the Libraries at Assumption College and the University of Windsor". It may eventually become an online Omeka exhibit.
